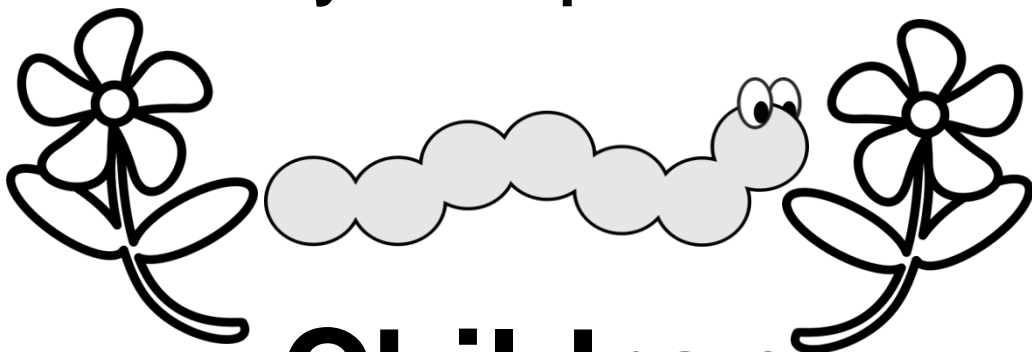

CLASSES FOR CHILDREN (SECTION G)

Trophy donated by Gill Lewington

In this Section there is a £1 first prize in each Class.

Certificates and rosettes are given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each Class.

The Lewington Trophy is awarded to the person with the most points in Section G and the winner of this will also receive a miniature trophy to keep.

Class

Age 4 and under (on date of the Show)

- 1G Decorate picture of a butterfly. Picture available in Lechlade Library and on Lechlade Gardening Club website
- 2G Decorate 3 biscuits. Biscuits can be shop bought

5 – 7 years old

- 3G An edible necklace (string does not need to be edible)
- 4G A garden in a recycled container no bigger than 38 cm x 25cm (eg seed tray)
- 5G An imaginary animal made with fruit and/or vegetables and/or plant material
- 6G A handmade item, any medium
- 7G Decorate a flowerpot (maximum size 15 cm diameter)

8 – 12 years old

- 8G A flower arrangement in a mug
- 9G 4 decorated cup cakes
- 10G A Lego model (not a kit) no bigger than 30 cm x 30 cm x 30 cm
- 11G A handmade item, any medium
- 12G An item made with recycled plastic

Photography for Children under 16

Entries should be unmounted, maximum size 10 cm X 15 cm

Section, Class number, Name, Address and Age should be written on reverse.

Any title may be put on a card available on the day.

Class

- 13G My pet
- 14G My favourite meal
- 15G A tree or trees

Tuesday 3rd September: Last date for handing in entry forms

Late entries will not be accepted

Saturday 7th September:

9:30 – 11:00 am	Bring your exhibits to the Memorial Hall You will be shown where to stage them
11:00 am	Leave the Hall
11:15 am	Judging begins
2:00 pm	Show open to the public and exhibitors
4:00 pm	Prize giving and raffle
4:30 pm	Take home your exhibits after the raffle.

RULES

1. Children's classes: entry fee – 10p per item entered.
2. Children may also enter adult classes – entry fee: 25p per item.
3. Items exhibited in previous years are not eligible.
4. All exhibits must be grown or made by the exhibitor with the exception of materials for flower arrangements.
5. Adult help may be given but must be appropriate to the age of the child.
6. Only one entry per person in any one class.
7. Entries may be disqualified if size is not adhered to.
8. Exhibits to be staged between 9:30 and 11:00 am.
9. Rosettes and certificates are awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each Class. Judges may decide not to award these in every class.
10. A 1st prize of £1.00 will also be awarded for each 1st place certificate. Prize money should be collected by the end of the Show. Any monies not claimed will be placed into club funds.
11. The Lewington Trophy, to be held for one year, will be awarded to the child with the highest aggregate points in the Children's Section. The winner will also receive a miniature trophy to keep.
12. No exhibits to be removed until after the raffle.
13. All exhibits to be removed by exhibitors by 5.00pm.
14. The club accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage.
15. The Lewington Trophy remains the property of the Lechlade Gardening Club and must be returned to the Treasurer by 31st July.

The Judges' decisions will be final.
